

TOWN OF MERRIMAC, MASSACHUSETTS
WALLACE WAY WATER TREATMENT PLANT
PRESSURE FILTER TANK CLEANING, PAINTING, AND REHABILITATION PROJECT

Sealed bids for the Wallace Way Water Treatment Plant Pressure Filter Tank Cleaning, Painting and Rehabilitation Project will be received at the Office of the Selectmen of the Town of Merrimac, the "OWNER", until 2:00 PM local time, on Friday, January 20, 2012, 4 School Street, Merrimac MA 01860. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. Each "BIDDER" must submit a single sealed envelope, the outside of which must be clearly marked as follows:

"Bid for Town of Merrimac, Massachusetts
Wallace Way Water Treatment Plant Pressure Filter Tank
Cleaning, Painting, and Rehabilitation Project
Contract No. WATER 1-12"

All work is included in a single contract and this work includes:

Removing and disposing of existing filter media in three 10-foot diameter, 10-foot high steel pressure filter tanks; removing and disposing of existing underdrain diffuser nozzles and air wash pipe grid; cleaning and preparing the interior surface of the tanks in accordance with SSPC SP10; painting the interior of tanks with new coating system; clean and prepare exterior surface of each tank including containment in accordance with SSPC SP3; painting the exterior surface with a new coating system; and disinfection of all three tanks. The new media, underdrain diffuser nozzles and air wash pipe grid shall be installed by others.
