Sunday Dec. 4 2011 1pm - Merrimac's Annual Christmas Parade

The parade starts at the Sweetser School on Church Street. It heads south on Church Street, turns right on West Main Street and then turns left on Union Street ending at the Donaghue School.

Sunday Dec. 4 2011 430pm - The Annual Tree Lighting
